Policy Type: Board Process Policy Title: C6 – Board Officers Last Revised: February 1, 2021

The Board shall elect officers in order to help us accomplish our job.

- I. No individual officer will have any authority to supervise or direct the GM.
- 2. Officers may delegate their authority but remain accountable for its use.
- 3. Regular Board officer elections shall be held annually at the Board meeting immediately following the annual Board election, once any newly elected directors are seated.
- 4. The officers shall be a president, a vice president, a secretary, and a treasurer. Individual directors may serve two officer positions simultaneously, but the president may not serve simultaneously as vice president or secretary.
- 5. The president shall ensure the Board acts consistently with all policies and bylaws of the Cooperative.
- 6. The president shall chair and prepare the agenda for Board meetings and work sessions.
- 7. The president may represent the Board to outside parties.
- 8. The vice president shall perform the duties of the president in the president's absence.
- 9. The secretary shall maintain and authenticate the records of the Cooperative. See Idaho Code Section 30-29-840 OFFICERS.
- 10. The secretary shall preside to appoint a temporary meeting chair in the event that both the president and the vice president are absent from a Board meeting.
- II. The treasurer will lead the Board's process for creating and monitoring the Board's budget.
- 12. The treasurer shall report on the financial condition of the Cooperative at the annual ownership meeting.
- 13. The officers shall plan for Board leadership perpetuation.
